The use of supporters, crests, awards, helms and other items in your SCA Heraldic Achievements.

Heraldic Display – Baroness Caitrina Inghean Aindriasa

Register on a Heater. Display on a Potato. Heraldic display in the Middle Ages. How to do it and what to avoid.

Tourney/Field Heraldry – Silver Yale, Vladimir Andreivich Aleksandrov

Tips for voice heralds in the field (whether town crying or tourney). Students will have the opportunity to practice their new skills during the afternoon's Prize Tournaments.

Heraldic Embroidery – HL Sine Gunnsodottir

Use and creation of heraldic markings in original ancient embroidery stitches. Comes with comprehensive kit that contains all you need to work on a patch in class as well as a number of items to continue after class.

Marshalling – HL Harleigh Dhair

This class will go over the fundamentals of Field marshalling to ensure safety and entertainment for all. Students will have the opportunity to put what they learned as Marshalls (In Training) during the afternoon's two Prize Tournaments.
