## [19:19] Exploring making the UBCO events more officially part of the SCA [19:20] Some benefits to the Shire:

- Insuring adequate insured coverage
- Increasing shire activities (for our Baronial path)
- Increasing UBCO student engagement in the SCA
- SCA participants could mentor student fighters one on one.
- Instead of calling it practice we could make it more like a learning session/workshop. (IE Shield day, showing the different advantages/disadvantages of shields and getting a chance to use them all.)
- SCA membership waivers would cover our liability. Non-members would sign waivers same as any SCA activity.
- Run it like a demo at a school where students are covered under their insurance and "demo participants" sign attendance sheets & waivers
- Caution around having the entire fighting community revolving around UBCO activities.

[19:21] Stein brings up that people lending equipment would require liability insurance [19:22] Any non-students participating could be open to being sued for losses if a student is injured while participating. If we have SCA waivers, we can mitigate that as we would be protected under that insurance.
