- Outcast Arms (Canadian sword supplier) has indicated they are planning an Economy Rapier, with a price point similar to, or less than, Castile. This would be preferable as it's a Canadian supplier with less duty and shipping costs.
- There are so many options for Gorgets and they all fall within \$75-\$150 USD, so I split the difference, but I am looking into less expensive options north of the border.
- I am requesting slightly more than the proposed costs due to shifting Canadian Dollar values and shipping costs.
