- Adding 'of Danescombe' to the end of the award name was passed in the July 2023 council meeting, Red Flame herald consult was imminent in the December 2023 meeting, waiting on mock-up of designs with clusters and mention of creating new moulds in February 2023 meeting, nothing in meeting minutes or chat that I can find beyond this (Chiara was the contact with the Red Flame Herald)
- We also were thinking about registering the yale head as a populous badge for Danescombe (Nov 21, 2023)
- We had a quote for 1000\$ for moulds (Jan 29th, 2024)
