Tournament of Roses - Event summary

[19:23] We had 2200 in profit!

[19:24] 5 Defenders and an Iron Rose tourney

[19:24] We should try to bolster bardic participation

[19:25] Good participation in A&S, Rapier, Heavy, and Cut & Thrust

[19:25] Maybe run bardic during the feast next year? Maybe have a Sing-for-your-Supper type event?

[19:26] Taliesen recommends that we better integrate Bardic into more events to make it more integral

[19:27] We had good class participation, Desiree ended up running a second one, Saif's went well

[19:28] Lunch went well, few 120ish people, feast went well, around 70 people

Practice Site Fees

[19:30] Proposal to increase our practice fees to 5\$ a practice rather than 15\$ for the month

[19:30] As we're expanding the spaces rented for our Thursday practice, we need 11 people per practice, if we reach out goal to have the entire gym, we need to have 28

[19:32] If we increase the cost to 5\$ per practice, it lowers the number of participants needed to 8 and 21

[19:32] Average attendance typically fluctuates between 11-13 (Not accounting for heavy)

[19:33] Once pickleball starts up again (after July-August), we'll lose the gym

[19:37] 5\$ per practice is a barrier to participation for many Shire members (especially if it's across the board for all practices)

[19:38] If we did 20\$ to cover all Shire activities, it would probably cover all of the spaces (including gym)

Seneschal – HE Steinn

Master of Stables – HE Steinn

- Armoured: HE Steinn
 - Finally restarted shire armoured practices in conjunction with the Rapier and Arts and Sciences on Thursdays at the Peachland Hall. Great to be actively part of the shire again.
 - New Danescombe Defender: Laric Godwin of Lionsgate was chosen at the Tournament of Roses. MIC report was submitted to the Event Steward.
- Archery Taitr
 - There were no shire archery practices in April, however, since the last shire council meeting we have had one shire archery practice. The May 7th practice went from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM and had 7 attendees.
 - There were no archery competitions scored due to a lack of targets and grass-cleared ground. The grass will continue to be cleared for the use of longer ranges in future practices. The shire archery practice used one shire target and two targets loaned by Viscount Sir Olen and myself. Of these targets, only my target would be large and heavy enough to hold the 60cm paper targets without falling to allow for the scoring of royal rounds.
 - I have ordered the 60cm paper targets (I am fine donating these to the shire but the council should decide whether to order them for the shire in the future), however, shipping times will prevent us from having them for the next 2 practices. To sustain the growth in archery provided there continues to be interest, I suggest the shire look into purchasing additional targets when they are on sale.

- Thrown Weapons HE Olen (Pending)
- Rapier Gawain
 - Rapier practice went well this month. We had an average of 13 people coming out to practice. This month we did open practices and encouraged rapier fighters to come with personal goals to work on their training. This, coupled with invaluable support from Master Murdoch, I believe led to a fruitful and enjoyable month of practices.
 - We had some new folks some from ToR and others just heard about us and wanted to try Rapier. With the good turnout numbers and the style of open practice, we did have some issues with space on a few of the days. Some folks did some rapier work outside (luckily warm enough to do so).
- Cut & Thrust Lord Tobias
 - We had 2 C&T practices with 2 people doing cut and thrust (and 3 people doing rapier).
 - We had a C&T tournament at ToR with 10 people.

Arts and Sciences – Archibald Archer

- April 11th: Open A&S night; 1 person doing leatherwork, 1 person sewing and 1 person working on tokens.
- April 13th: Tournament of Roses occurred, A&S competition and new champion chosen.
 Crafting Haversacks with Mistress Desiree Aurelia Chiarestella class held.
- April 26th: 3 people working on fleece preparation doing flicking and hand carding.

Chatelaine – Master Murdoch

- The month of April saw an uptick in inquiries and new people attending events! With Tourney of Roses on the 13th, the Shire had several newcomers attend the event. They were engaged by multiple Shire members and encouraged to return. One family was from the North and I've referred them to our neighbors in Krakenfjord. I remain in contact with the family as they are excited to attend Danescombe events in the future as well.
- Shire Rapier practice had 3 newcomers attend and pick up a sword and were tended to by Gawain, Tobias and Vera.
- As for email, we've had two external inquiries about demos at events locally. I will be responding to those emails shortly and bringing possibilities to Shire Council.

Scribe – HE Taliesin

- We continued to hold Scribal Nights, in conjunction with our Weekly Fighter Practices, on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month.
- Out attendance fluctuates from week to week but we have a core of 3 or 4 people weekly, with 2 or 3 others that pop in from time to time.
- In April, we sent 6 Kingdom Charters, 2 Principality Charters, 16 Principality Thank You Notes and 1 Principality Promissory note down to Canterbury Fayre to be passed along to the respective Royal and Coronet Scribes.

- We currently have no Kingdom Charters on hand, as all have been painted and returned.
 We have 5 Principality Charters on hand, and the expectation is that they will be completed and passed along at June Coronet. In addition, I have been provided the 'pdfs' of the current reigns charters so that I can print a few additional wants for painting as the Principality is short a couple of specific award charters.
- The Historical Arts & Combat Club is now closed for the summer and it is anticipated that Scribal support will resume in the Fall. I will continue to attend on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month, offering Painting and Calligraphy support (classes).

Webminister – Lord Drazhan

 I just got a response about what is going on with the old website. The old website has been removed and the old URL no longer works. Work is underway to make the old URL work again, but will take some time. Some of the shire sites were set up with the Kingdom account instead of the Principality account, making them impossible to administrate or modify without taking it up with Kingdom. Sites included in this are Danescombe, Coil Mohr, and Lionsgate.
